## Customer Information on RoHS Compliance

Dear Customers,

we thank you for your interest in the compliance of our manufacture service with EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2). EC Directive 2002/95/EG (RoHS 1) has been superseded by EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2) which took effect on 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2013.

The regulation on substances in electric and electronic devices dated 19/4/2013 implements the so-called RoHS guideline for the ban on hazardous substances in electronic devices in Germany.

The regulation thus serves to implement Directive 2011/65/ EU of the European Parliament and the Council of 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 on the restricted use of certain hazardous substances in electronic devices (ABl. L 174 dtd. 1/7/2011, page 88).

The regulation refers to the putting into circulation and placing on the market of new electric and electronic devices, defining the ban on substances such as lead, cadmium, chrome (V), mercury and poly-brominated flame retardants in newly distributed electric and electronic devices.

We wish to inform you with this letter that our manufacturing service covers the lead-free process based on the described RoHS-Directive, as well as the lead process on customers wish in accordance with paragraph 15, sub-clause 2, sentence 3, ElektroStoffV up to and including 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2017.

As a leading manufacturer of electric measuring and test equipment, however, we feel committed to the protection of the environment and are sensitive to the problems involved in the use of harmful substances.

Following the requirements set forth in ElektroStoffV, we therefore use materials and apply methods without harmful substances in order to achieve compliance with ElektroStoffV in spite of the exemption.
