## Customer Information on TSCA (Toxic Substances Control Act)

Dear Customers,

MTP Messtechnik Produktions GmbH is committed to minimizing the use of substances that are suspected to be hazardous to health or the environment.

Section 6(h) of the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act of the United States, dated June 22, 2016, mandates the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the American counterpart to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), to take expedited action on certain persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals. The goal is to reduce associated risks and exposure to these chemicals as much as possible.

On January 6, 2021, the EPA issued final regulations to reduce exposure to the following PBT chemicals. The regulations have been effective since March 2021:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE), CAS 1163-19-5
- Phenol, isopropylated, phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1), CAS 68937-41-7
- 2,4,6-Tris(1,1-dimethylethyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP), CAS 732-26-3
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd), CAS 87-68-3
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP), CAS 133-49-3

MTP Messtechnik Produktions GmbH adheres strictly to legal and regulatory obligations for the control and restriction of chemicals. To the best of our knowledge, none of the above-listed chemicals are present in our products.
